Core extract from the Gospel (John 20: 26-28); for reflection throughout the week)

A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them.
Although the doors were shut,
Jesus came and stood among them and said,
'Peace be with you.'
Then he said to Thomas,
'Put your finger here and see my hands.
Reach out your hand and put it in my side.
Do not doubt but believe.'
Thomas answered him,
'My Lord and my God!'

Things to do


- Play a whisper messenger game and see if you can successfully whisper the message to each other.

You will need: 2 paper cups, 2 paper clips, string, the longer the better!



Make a hole in the bottom of each cup.







Push the other end of the string through the hole in one cup and pull through so that the paper clip is inside the cup.



Thread the other end of the string through the hole in the other cup. Start from the outside and then tie the string to the last paper clip, inside the cup.

Pull the string taut between the cups and speak to a friend.
