Core extract from the Gospel (Luke 3: 3-4, 6; for reflection throughout the week)

John went into all the region around the Jordan, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins, as it is written in the book of the words of the prophet Isaiah, 'The voice of one crying out in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. And all flesh shall see the salvation of God."

Things to think about

Things to do

- Make colourful paper chains to hang around your house.
- Wrap green wool around a card triangle to make a Christmas tree. Add small pompoms as baubles.
- Paper snowflakes

You will need: 6 squares of paper, scissors, pencil, ruler, glue or stapler.





Fold the paper square in half diagonally.


Draw a line from the point to the base.

Cut along these lines from the fold almost to the centre line



Open out the paper

Take the centre section, curl around your finger and glue together.

Repeat these steps with each piece of paper


until you have six segments.
