**THE GOSPEL READING FOR THIS WEEK IS: Mission of the seventy  
(Luke 10:1-11, 16-20)**

*Core extract from the Gospel (Luke 10: 1-2; for reflection throughout the week)*

The Lord appointed seventy others  
and sent them on ahead of him in pairs  
to every town and place where he himself intended to go.  
He said to them,  
‘The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few;  
therefore ask the Lord of the harvest  
to send out labourers into his harvest.’

*Gospel prayer (for use throughout the week)*

Lord Jesus Christ,  
you sent your messengers  
to prepare the way before you.  
Send us out in your name  
to share your good news with others,  
that all may hear of your love and power;  
for you are our God.  
Amen.





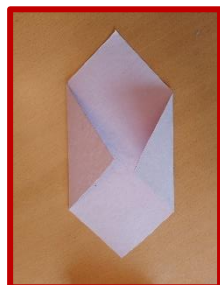
*Things to think about*

- How do you feel when you receive a letter or parcel?

*Things to do*

- Play a guessing game by wrapping up objects for other people to guess. Try to use the most unusual objects or disguise objects as something else.
- Design a stamp to be used on a present or letter. You will still need to use a real stamp if you are posting a letter!
- Message board.

You will need: paper squares, glue, scissors, and a large piece of paper or card.



Cut squares out of coloured paper or card.

Fold the sides of the square to the middle.



Fold the bottom point up and glue to the side pieces

Stick the envelopes onto a larger piece of card or paper. One for each member of your family and label with their names.



Use the envelopes to deliver messages to your family.
