THE GOSPEL READING FOR THIS WEEK IS: Good Samaritan (Luke 10: 25-37)

Core extract from the Gospel (Luke 10: 30, 33-34; for reflection throughout the week)

Jesus replied,
'A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho,
and fell into the hands of robbers,
who stripped him, beat him, and went away,
leaving him half dead.
But a Samaritan while travelling came near him;
and when he saw him, he was moved with pity.
He went to him and bandaged his wounds,
having poured oil and wine on them.
Then he put him on his own animal,
brought him to an inn, and took care of him.'

Gospel prayer (for use throughout the week)

Lord Jesus Christ,
you teach your disciples
to follow the example of the good Samaritan.
Help us to respond to the needs of others,
with sensitivity, generosity and care,
that we may show your love to the world;
for you are our God.
Amen.





Things to think about

- Do you know all your neighbours?
- Have you ever helped someone you don't know? What did you do?
- Have you ever needed to be helped by a stranger? Why?

Things to do

- See if you can help a neighbour with some simple tasks, gardening, carrying shopping. Always make sure your parents know where you are and who you are helping. They may need to help too!
- Make a model street using cardboard boxes. Try and make it look like where you live.
- Love your neighbour heart.

You will need: red paper, scissors, glue, googly eyes, pen.



Cut one large and 4 small hearts from the red paper.

Cut 4 strips of white paper and concertina fold them all.



Stick the smaller hearts on to the ends of the white strips.

Attach the white strips as arm and legs on to the large red heart.



Draw a face, add the googly eyes and write Love God, Love your neighbour.
