You will need: 25 small glass jars or glasses, tissue paper, PVA glue and tea lights





Using the PVA glue, cover the outside of the jars with small pieces of tissue paper. You could place them randomly or make a pattern with the colours.

Place the tea lights in the votives and place on a window sill or mantelpiece.

Remember, never leave lit candles unattended.
